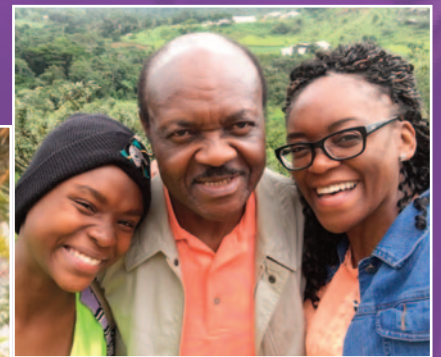

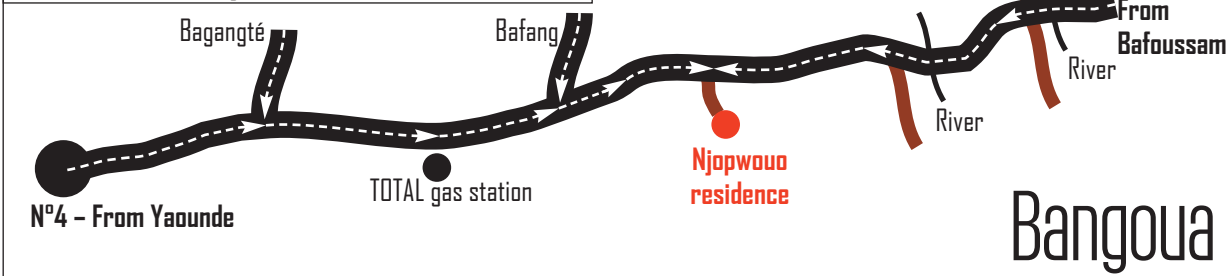

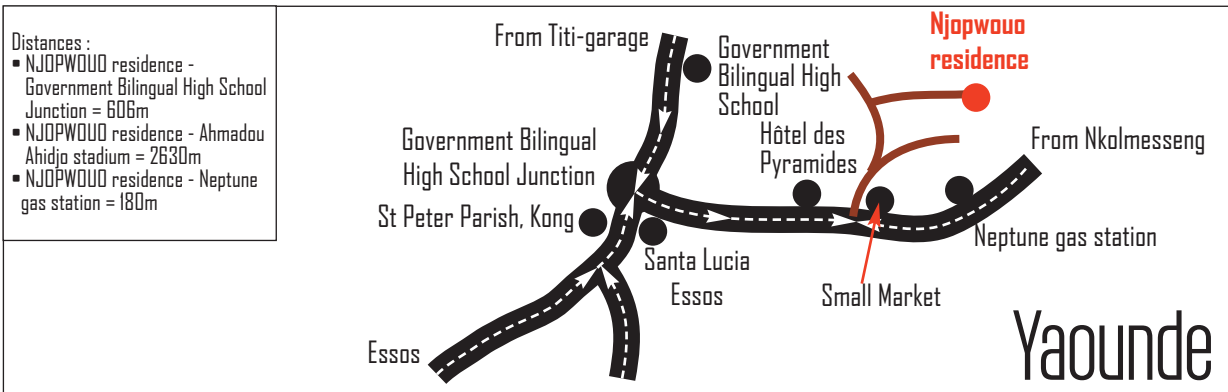
## Distances :
